The Distinguished Scholarship Invitational is one of the area's most prominent scholarship competitions, including **THREE \$64,000** Harry Gore Memorial Scholarships—**THREE OF THE LARGEST** annual undergraduate scholarships in Kansas.

 - Rank in the top 10% of your class at the end of your junior year

KOCH SCHOLARS COMPETITION: \$30,000-\$45,000

High school seniors are invited to compete for SEVEN HONORS COLLEGE KOCH SCHOLARSHIPS worth up to \$7,500 each year for in-state tuition, fees, room and board or up to \$11,250 for out-of-state students.

- Be a graduate from a Kansas high school
- Submit Wichita State admission materials by Oct. 15, 2020
- Meet the following criteria:
- Have a minimum cumulative 3.5 GPA
- Submit the Distinguished Scholarship Invitational scholarship application by Nov. 1
- Compete in the Distinguished Scholarship Invitational on Nov. 21

- Have a minimum ACT composite score of 21, or
- Have a minimum SAT composite of 1060

PASSAGE 2 SUCCESS SCHOLARSHIP:



A special award for at least **TEN FIRST-GENERATION STUDENTS**, with financial need, who compete in the Distinguished Scholarship Invitational. Awards are dispersed in amounts ranging from **\$2,000 TO \$5,000** per year.

TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE, YOU MUST:

- Be a 2021 high school graduate
- Submit Wichita State application materials by Oct. 15, 2020
- · Meet one of the following criteria:
 - Have a minimum unweighted 3.5 GPA, or
 - Have a minimum ACT composite score of 27, or
 - Have a minimum SAT composite of 1280, or
 - Rank in the top 10% of your class at the end of your junior year
- Meet the Wichita State priority date of Dec. 1 for submission of the 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Students who are ineligible to complete a FAFSA will be contacted to provide a separate statement describing their financial need
- Recipients will be required to participate in the Passage 2 Success Program

FRESHMEN MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS: \$8,000 - \$24,000

- \$2,000 \$4,000 a year for Kansas residents
- \$3,000 \$6,000 a year for nonresidents
- Scholarship awarded over four years with eligibility
- Award offers are based on high school GPA and national test score (ACT/SAT)
- Nov. 1 priority date for consideration

WICHITA STATE HONORS COLLEGE MERIT SCHOLARSHIP: \$1,000

\$500 a year over two years for incoming freshmen who are fully admitted to Wichita State and to the Wichita State Honors College.

• Priority consideration given to incoming freshmen and transfers who are fully admitted to Wichita State and to the Wichita State Honors College by Nov. 1.

WICHITA STATE NATIONAL MERIT AND NATIONAL **HISPANIC RECOGNITION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS:** \$50,000

- \$20,000 for the first year
- \$10,000 for each of the next three years
- Good for four years with eligibility

Transfer Merit Scholarship: \$4,000 - \$6,000

\$2,000 - \$3,000 for two years for new, incoming domestic transfer students coming directly to Wichita State from another institution with at least 12 credit hours but less than 90 and working on their first bachelor's degree.

IN-STATE OR REDUCED TUITION

Students from Colorado, Illinois, Indiana, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Texas and Wisconsin may qualify for in-state or reduced tuition.
